The Gallery celebrates local artists in this exhibition of works on board

3 November – 10 February 2019

Wollongong Art Gallery invites local artists to 'get on board' and celebrate the Gallery's 40th Anniversary by participating in a group exhibition.

Local artists are invited to register to receive one 60 x 80cm plywood board to create their work on. Painting, works on paper, photography, sculpture and all other art forms are encouraged as long as the 60 x 80cm board is used as the ground for the piece.

Artists must register to be part of the show on Eventbrite, and collect their boards from Wollongong Art Gallery from 19 June 2018. As there is a **one board per artist** limit and only 198 boards available, be quick to register so you don't miss out!

The resulting exhibition will be an installation of 198 boards over the entire 2nd level of the Gallery, celebrating the vibrant local artists' community. Space will be allocated for each artist to describe their practice and connection to the Illawarra.

CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION

1. Locals on Board is open to residents within the boundary of Helensburgh in the north, the Southern Highlands in the west and Gerringong in the south.
2. Local artists must register to participate and will be given one 60 x 80cm B/C grade 12mm thick plywood board per participant.
3. Registration and participation in the exhibition is free of charge for participants and is limited to 198 artists.
4. Artists must register on-line using Eventbrite. Artists must provide their details and a short statement about their practice and connection to the Illawarra region. Please contact the Gallery on 4227 8500 to provide your details if you do not have internet access.
5. The work must be the original, unaided work of the registered participant and have been completed in the four months prior to the exhibition date on the board provided by the Gallery.
6. The work submitted must use the board as a ground, canvas, paper, paint etc. may be adhered to the board to provide a surface for the work. Elements of any 2D work must not exceed 60 x 80cm. A sculpture or 3D work may be submitted using the board as the base. The overall work shall not exceed 80 cm high x 60 x 80cm. The board may be utilised as a screen for moving image works, please consult with the Gallery regarding the technology required to project an image.
7. Name, address and phone number of entrant and title of the work must be clearly marked on the back of the work.
8. The works, once completed are the property of the participating artist and can be sold through the Gallery.
9. The price of works which are for sale must be clearly marked on the back of the work.
10. A commission of 20% will be deducted from all sales.
11. No works may be removed during the exhibition.
12. Insurance is the full responsibility of the entrant. The Gallery will exercise all care but will accept no liability or responsibility for loss or damage of works.
13. Delivery and collection of works will be the full responsibility of the entrant. Works not collected by the date specified will be disposed of at the discretion of the Gallery.
14. Entrants shall allow their work to be reproduced for publicity purposes and waive any copyright claims in this instance.
