This day-long workshop will use cane, bandaging and rice paper to create lightweight but durable forms. The workshop is designed to be accessible for all ability levels, and easily transferrable to the classroom setting requiring a minimum amount of tool. The sculpture technique explored can be extended into large scale group pieces, or used for individual student projects, and is also ideal for creating works for local area sculpture exhibitions.

We will explore the work of two female sculptors, Bronwyn Oliver and Odine Lang, with written resources for teachers to take back to their classrooms.
